3. CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL MEETING.

A. Members reported that the following highway issues raised have not been completed by Denbighshire County Council:-

1. Highway between Cyffylliog Village and Ysgeibion Farm requires urgent repairs.
2. Highway between Henblas and Pentre Farm in Cyffylliog requires urgent repairs.
3. Cyffylliog Old Vicarage highway hedge requires cutting as the hedge is obstructing the highway.
4. The damaged highway cattle grid between Cyffylliog Village and From Farm requires urgent repairs.
5. Urgent work required on the highway via Cae'r Weirglodd.

B. Denbighshire County Councillor Joseph Welch reported that Mr Tim Towers, Risk and Asset Manager, is still assessing the works required on the highway via The Mount on the Bontuchel to Ruthin highway.
