### 2. CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL MEETING.

Members confirmed 8<sup>th</sup> September 2014 minutes as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

### 3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.

- A. Denbighshire County Council confirmed that the reason for not providing a highway safety barrier on the Tan-yr-Hengoed Bend in Bontuchel is that the work does meet the criteria of the "Design Manual for Roads and Bridges". County Councillor Joe Welch agreed to contact Marc Musgrave, Safer Roads Officer, to discuss the safety issue further.
- B. Denbighshire County Council confirmed that it is not their policy to collect side waste. The County have a relevant Training Officer who can advise householders on waste if required.
