

MINUTES OF THE CYFFYLLIOG COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 12TH JANUARY 2015 IN THE CHAPEL VESTRY, CYFFYLLIOG AT 7.00 P.M.

PRESENT: Councillors Huw Jones (Chairman), Emrys Williams, Philip Williams, Gethin Jones, Eifion Jones, Denbighshire County Councillor Joe Welch and the Clerk.

1. APOLOGIES: Councillors Kate Edge, Glyn Jones and Oswyn Jones.

2. CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL MEETING.

Members confirmed 10th November 2014 minutes as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.

- A. Members confirmed the text of the bi-lingual signs for the removal of waste at two Cyffylliog Cemeteries with Councillor Philip Williams who is organising the order.
- B. County Councillor Joe Welch reported that Denbighshire County Council has quoted £35,000.00 for the erection of a safety barrier on the Tan-yr-Hengoed highway bend in Bontuchel. Members resolved for the Clerk to receive quotations from local Street Works Contractors for the works required on the Tan-yr-Hengoed highway bend in the first instance.

 - 2. Blocked highway culvert on the highway leading up to Pen-y-Gelli, Bontuchel.
 - 3. Highway repair works is required on the Hiraethog road via Cae'r Wierglodd in Bontuchel.
